As the cooks helper you will be part of the food preparation team, baking, serving, and clean-up of the kitchen to meet all standards set out by the First Cook. In conjunction with the First Cook, the Cooks Helper is responsible for the organization, cleanliness, efficiency, and smooth running of the kitchen. The Cooks Helper shares in responsibility for quality of food and service in the Tea Room. Preparation and clean up of Dinner Theatre meals, lunch and special events are regular duties of this position. This person will assist with functions, events and special education programs as related to Tea Room duties.

- Read and follow all prep lists
- Preparation and clean – up of work stations
- Opening and closing duties of the restaurant kitchen which can include cleaning duties of the Tea Room
- Maintain a high level of customer service
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and commitment to teamwork in a friendly, caring atmosphere
- Adhere to sanitation standards as outlined by the Public Health Department
- Promote professional work habits that will develop respect and will create return business from customers

- Physically fit, with ability to lift heavy loads (35 kg)
