Your help is needed with:

## **Reception**

Greet visitors and make them welcome as you explain the history of the R.J. Haney property, museum exhibits and events. You will also operate the gift shop in the same area.

## **Dinner Theatre**

Lend your talents to the cook in the kitchen as people enjoy the July and August productions. Assist with preparation for the dinner service during the day & serving & bussing during the evening.

## **Serving & Bussing**

Help in the Pancake serving or flipping pancakes, as well as the BBQ grill for hamburgers & smokies and lunch service.

## **Ice Cream & Popcorn**

Scoop Ice cream cones, serve popcorn, pop & water. We usually have a couple of people working under the gazebo for this one.

## **Cahiers**

Stationed in the food tent & Ice cream section, selling raffle tickets, or food tickets

## **Parking & Gate Admission**

Assist in directing traffic to the appropriate lots, and parking spaces. Gate attendees take care of admission charges at the gate as traffic enters the park.

## **Construction/Maintenance & Set up/take down**
