R.J. Haney Heritage Village and Museum has a unique opportunity for student summer employment. Situated on 40 acres of farmland on the east side of Salmon Arm the Village offers a unique cultural heritage experience for the traveling and local public from mid May to the end of September, and welcomes over 15,000 visitors each year. The Village, Museum and Marjorie's Tea Room also hosts special events, and Villains and Vittles Dinner Theatre 3 nights per week during July and August.

We are seeking candidates as part of the Visitor Services Team. We can promise you a memorable and gainful working experience as a Heritage Interpreter supporting the day to day operation of the Heritage Village and Museum and greeting visitors.

The ideal candidate should have an interest in history and historical events and be willing to learn about our local history. Successful candidates assist in the educational programs, promotion of site interpretation and the Village's activities and depict the local history as an actor in the live show or part of the stagecraft team in the 25 live performances of our dinner theatre production during July and August.

Candidates will be part of the "Haney Players" and bring the history of Salmon Arm to life by performing as significant figures from the era 1911 to 1930. Haney Players deliver scripted monologues during guided interpretive tours of the Heritage Village, Museum and R.J. Haney House and during our special education programs and community events.

Candidates should have strong communication skills and be energetic, out-going and punctual, and work autonomously within a team environment. Experience with Microsoft Word and Publisher would be an asset, but will be taught. Have an interest in theatre, excellent voice projection skills and be able to creatively improvise while remaining in character.

This is a full-time 16 week position from May to the end of August, and you must be available to work evenings, weekdays and holidays. Candidates must currently be in studies and will be returning to school in the fall. You must be between the ages of 16 and 30, a Canadian citizen, be willing to register in the YCW inventory, be willing to commit to the full duration of the work dates and treat this as their primary job. Consideration will be given to students still in full time studies until the end of June for an alternate start date or part-time hours until school is finished for the year.
