Job Description: Heritage Restoration Assistant

Employment Type: Fill-Time, Seasonal 2019 May-August

R.J. Haney Heritage Village and Museum has a unique employment opportunity for youth between the ages of 15-30. Situated on 40 acres of farmland on the east side of Salmon Arm the Village offers a unique cultural heritage experience for the travelling and the local public from mid-May to the end of September and welcomes over 16,000 visitors each year. The Village, Museum and Marjorie's Tea Room also hosts special events, and Villains and Vittles Dinner Theatre 3 nights per week during July and August. The mandate of the organization is to preserve the heritage of the area and develop a Village depicting life in the era of 1911 to 1930.

We are seeking a candidate as part of the Construction and Maintenance Team. We can promise you a memorable and gainful working experience as the Heritage Restoration Assistant. The successful candidate will work on the scheduled projects for the season. This department historically preserves and restores the buildings and constructs exhibits as they would have appeared in Salmon Arm from 1910 to 1935.

Applicants should have some basic construction skills and be enthusiastic to learn new tasks. The use of power tools and safe operation will be taught. You should have good interpersonal skills as the Village attracts hundreds of visitors over the summer. This position also works as a team member on the community events throughout the season.

This is a full-time 16-week position from mid-May to the end of August, and you must be available to work evenings, weekdays and holidays. Candidates must be between the ages of 15 and 30, and be willing to commit to the full duration of the work dates and treat this as their primary job.

Consideration will be given to students who are still in full-time studies until the end of June for an alternate start date or part-time hours until school is finished for the year.
